

## Multichanel File for GO ColorMate™

Create Photoshop Multichannel Files to be Used on ColorMate™

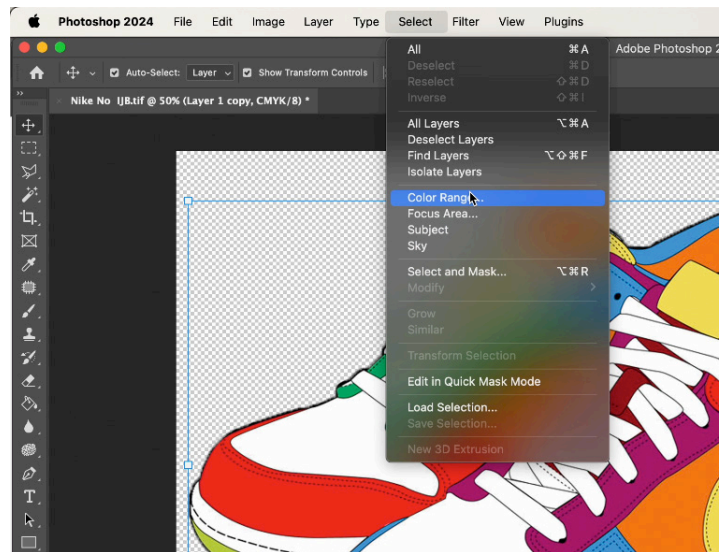
This bulletin describes the Step-by-Step Guide to creating multichannel files that will be used in ColorMate™ for screen printing.

The process of manually separating flat colors using Photoshop is as follows:

1. Prepare your image. Make sure it is in Bitmap mode and CMYK to divide it into different colors.



2. Goto Select Menu and click on Color Range.



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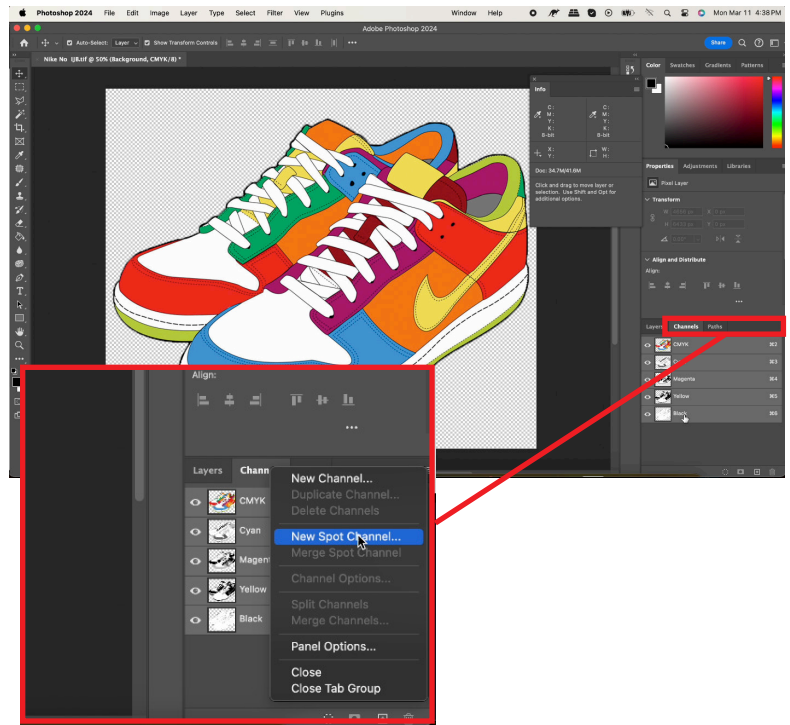
3. Use the picker to click on the color to be selected.

Use the Fuzziness slider to select the selection level.

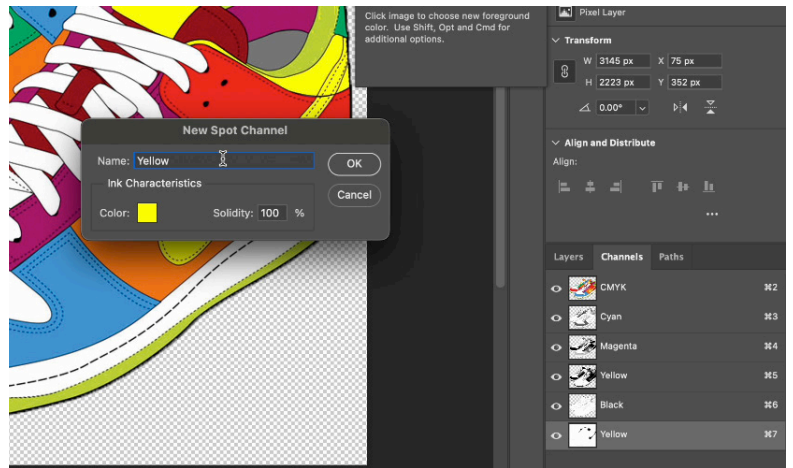


4. In the Channels Tab, select the “Hamburger Menu” on the right and choose New Spot Channel.

The selection will appear as a new channel.



Rename the Channel and click on the Color to select a color similar to the one in the image.



Repeat the process for each color.

More channels will show up on every step.



5. Once all the channels are ready, change the mode of the image to Multichannel and save it as PSD.
