

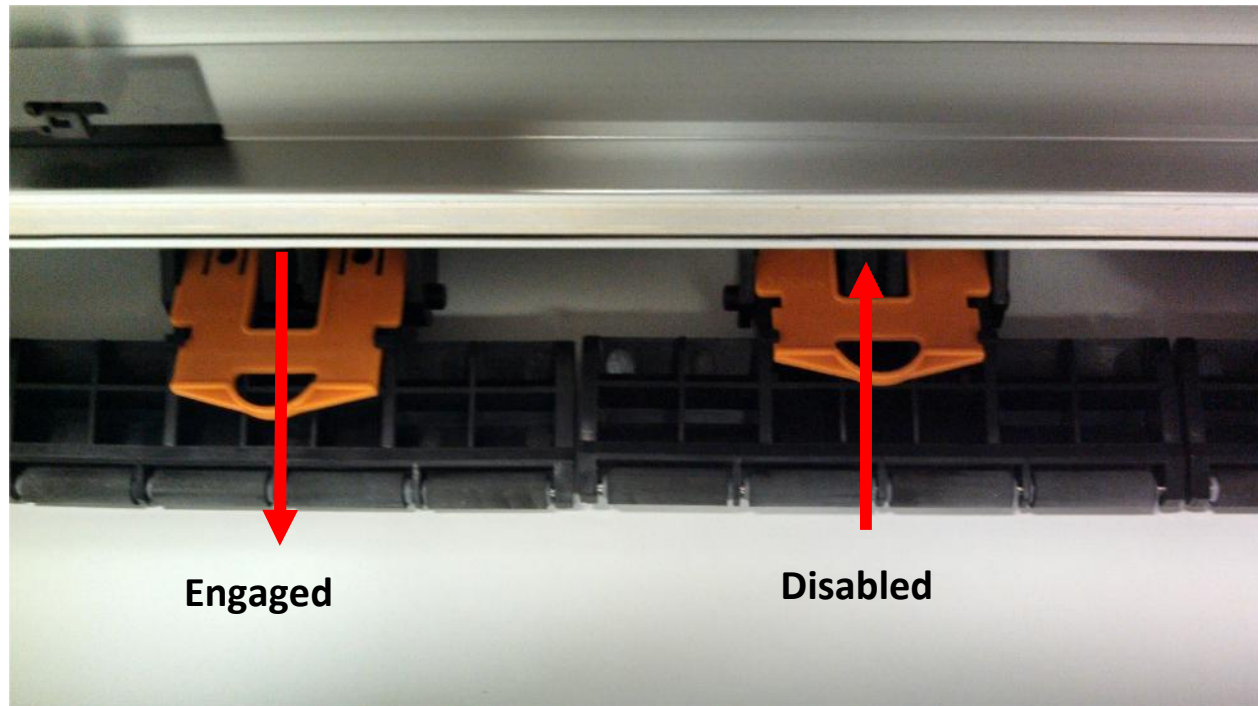
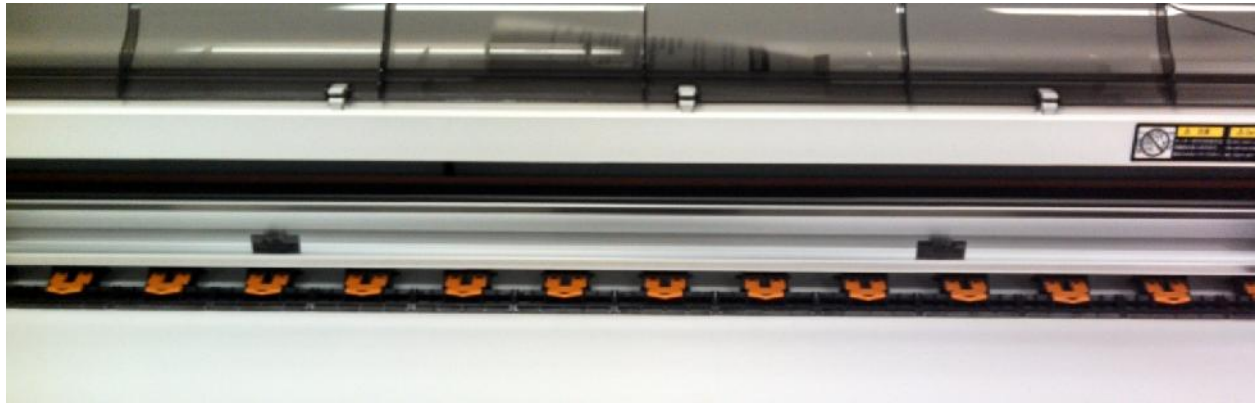
New Pressure Roller Design - RJ-900X



The newly re-designed RJ-900x has incorporated, among other improvements, an innovative new pressure roller system designed for printing on transfer papers for dye sublimation applications. This new design gives the operator the ability to individually disable the pressure rollers to allow the transfer paper to expand without cockling, greatly reducing the chance for head strikes and the need for extra media edge guides¹. This new roller cancellation function is very simple to use and fully customizable for different paper types and ink load requirements.

¹ Media edge guides may increase the chance of head strikes by not allowing the paper to expand outward in a controlled manner.

Each roller has an orange slide lock lever to either engage or cancel that roller. When the main pressure roller lever is in the UP position, you can slide the orange slide lock back to cancel each roller individually.



If the papers start to cockle causing head strikes, it is recommended to cancel/disable the first 2-4 rollers on both edges of the media, depending on media width. Keep as many rollers as needed engaged in the center of the media to ensure proper feeding.
