

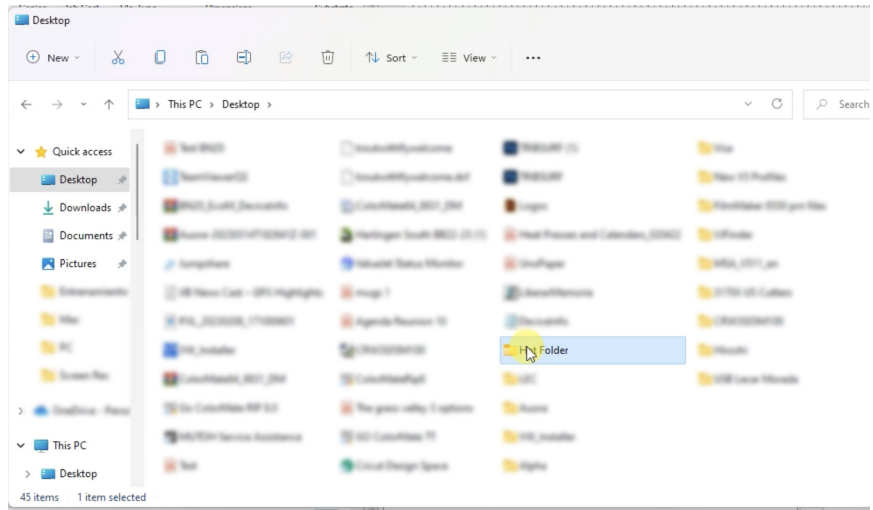
FilmMaker™ HotFolders

FilmMaker™ RIP HotFolders Setup.

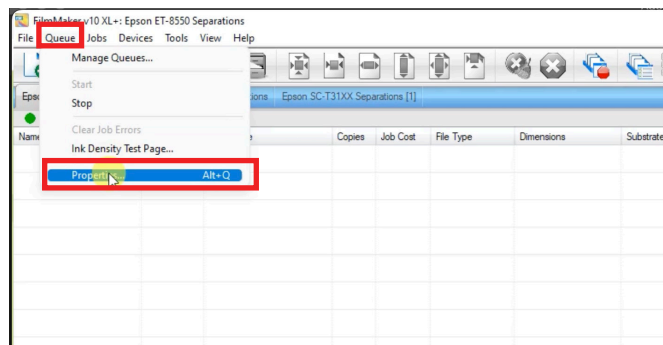
This bulletin describes the procedure for the HotFolders setup in FilmMaker™ Rip Software.

A HotFolder allows everyone in the network to save a file in a specific folder and then have this file printed through FilmMaker™ RIP.

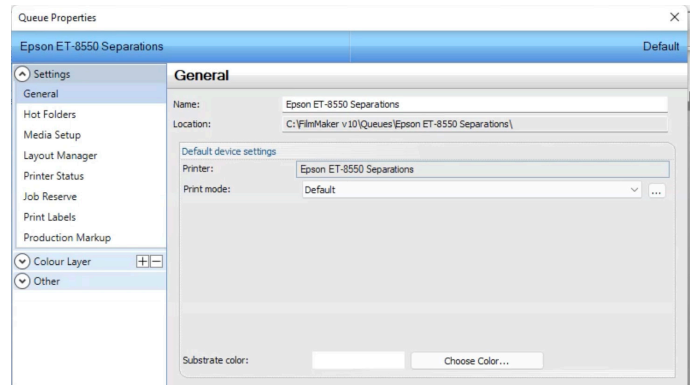
1. In your computer, create a Folder that will be used as a HotFolder in the FilmMaker™ RIP Software.



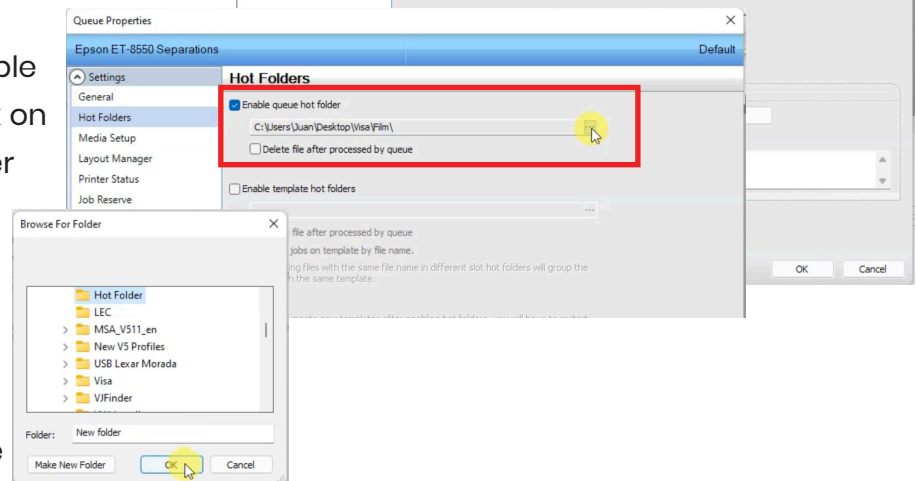
2. In your FilmMaker™ RIP, go to the **Queue Menu** and select **Properties**.



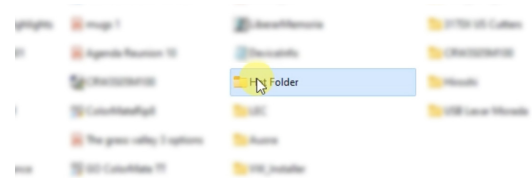
3. On the **Queue Properties** window, select **Hot Folders**.



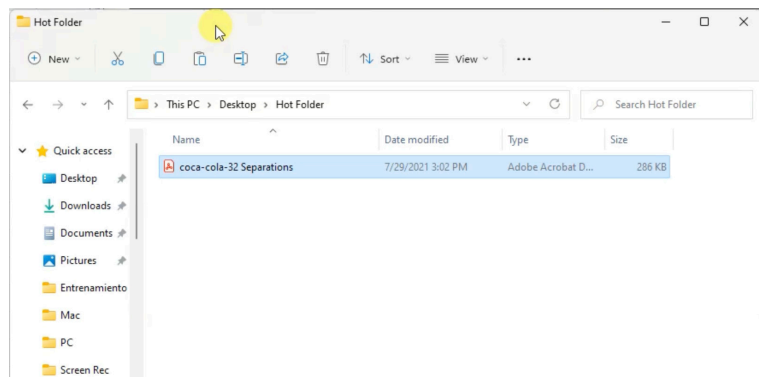
In the **Hot Folders** section, enable the **Queue Hot Folder** and click on the three dots next to the folder name.

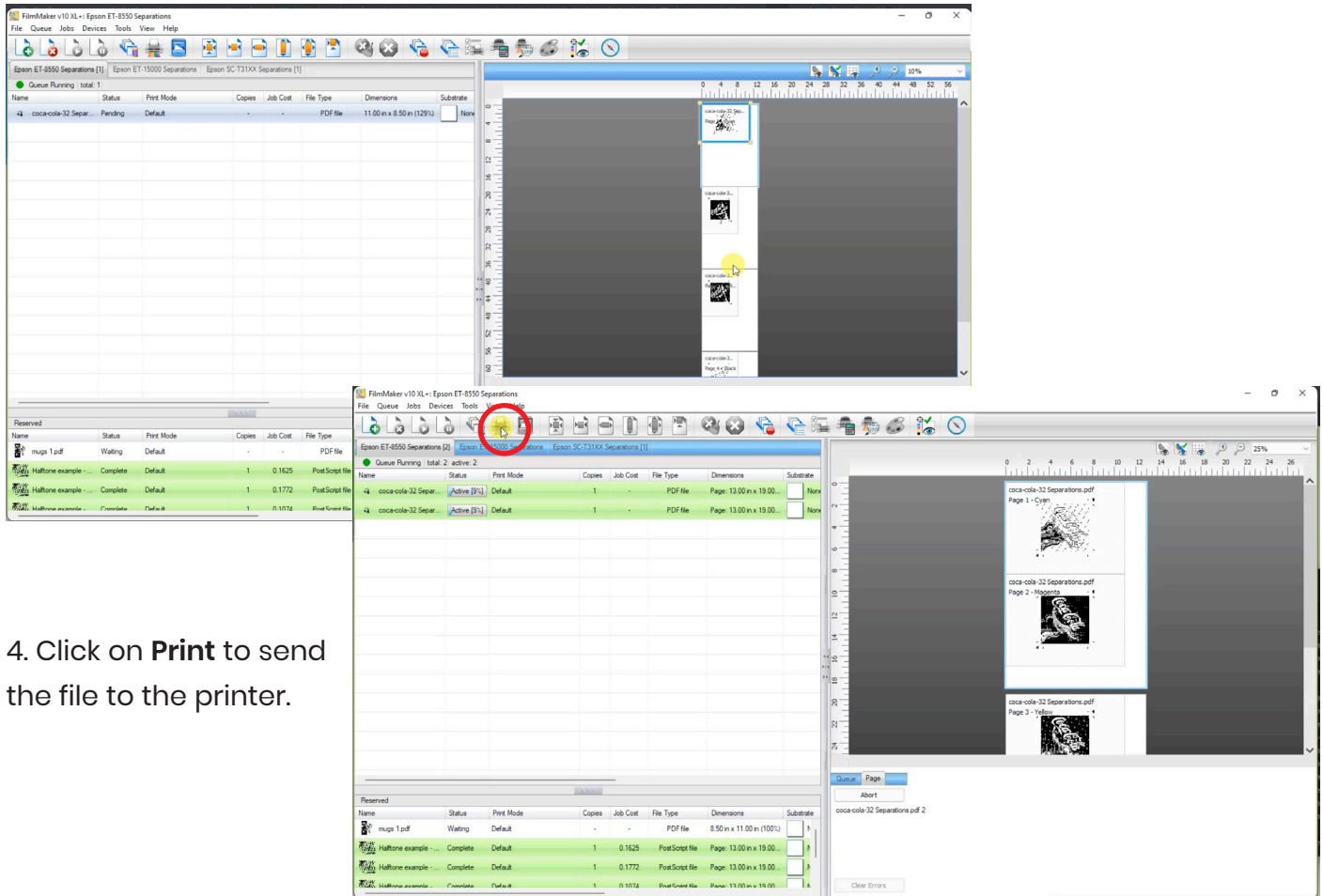


Select the pre-defined Hot Folder that will be used to save the files.



The files saved in the Hot Folder will automatically open in the FilmMaker™ RIP.





4. Click on **Print** to send the file to the printer.
