

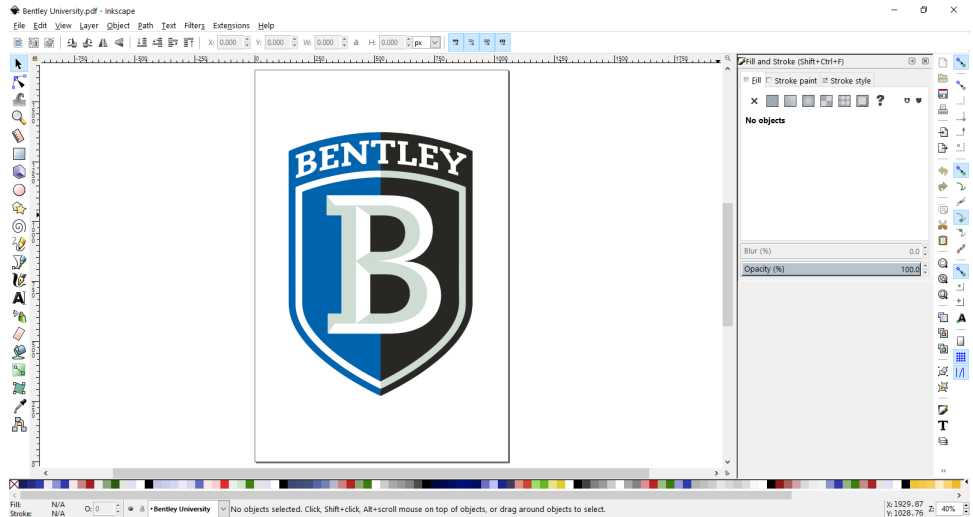
Easy Color Separations, ScreenMate™

How to create Easy Color Separations

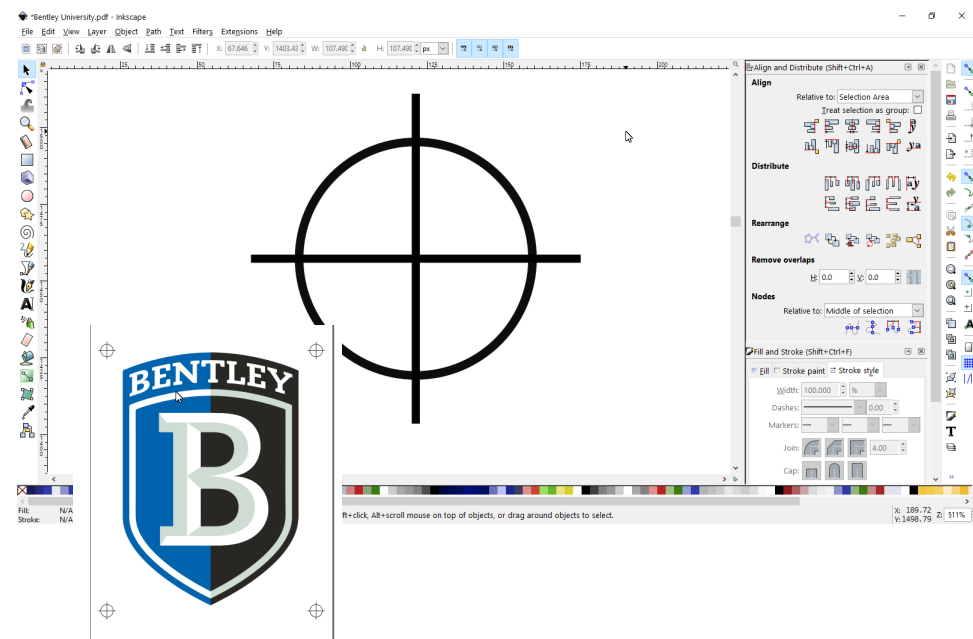
This bulletin describes the procedure on printing easy color separations using a design software.

Note: The images are from InkScape software but same procedure can be used on CorelDraw or Illustrator.

1. Open your file in the application



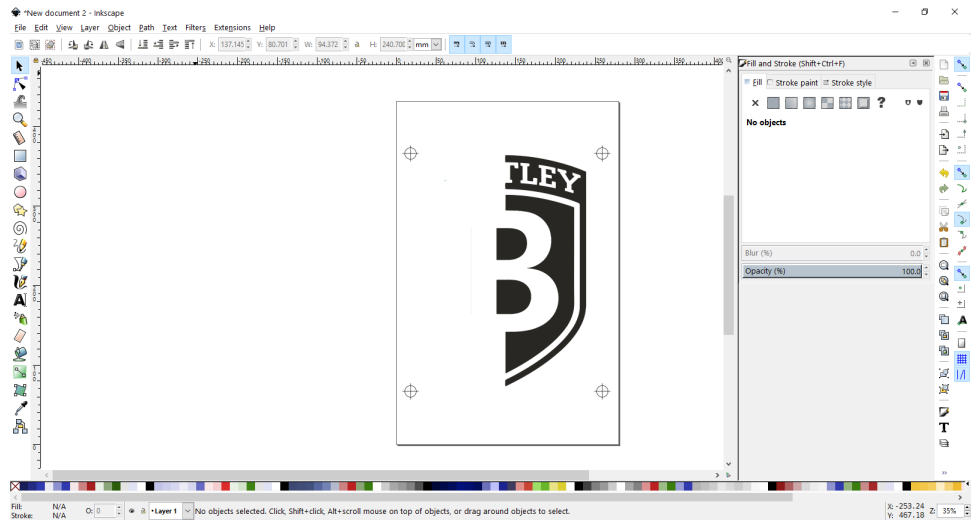
Create or Import your Registration Marks and place them in the 4 corners of the image



Copy all the elements and
paste them on a ***new page**

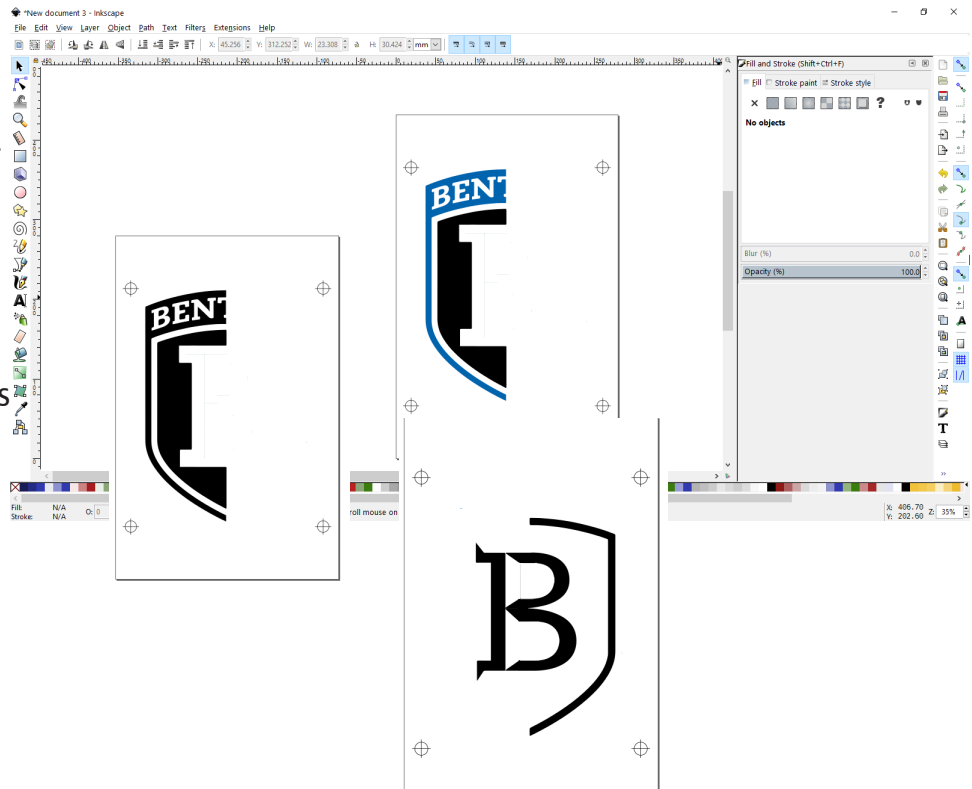
*On InkScape, create a new
document with the same
page size from the original
image and paste the images

Once you paste it, erase all
the other colors and leave
only one of the colors of the
image.



Repeat the steps for all
other colors in the file and
change every selected color
to black since we are
printing a color separation.

Once you have all the pages
ready, send it to Print.



2. Print your file.

Select your printer and click on Properties.

In the driver settings, choose you **Paper Size**, **Paper Type** and **Quality**.

Note: The Photo papers in the Paper Type menu, will laydown more ink than the Plain Plaper. Select the one that give more density to the print.
