Procedures for unpacking boxes are explained. This product is packaged separately, divided into the printer and the stand.



- While taking out the printer from the box, make sure to remove the vinyl sheet

# 1.1 Unpacking printer box

- 2. Remove the bands.
- 3. Open the box and take out the following components.

# 3.1 The stand assembling procedure


If you will use the stand, assemble it in accordance with the following steps.

- 1. Follow the steps shown below to assemble the right side of the stand.
  - a. Install the (right) support to the leg so that the caster with the lock is on the front.
  - b. Fasten two hexagon socket head cap screws with the enclosed hexagonal wrench.





2. Assemble the left side of the stand in a similar way to step 1.

- 3. Follow the steps shown below to attach the central beam to the legs (left, right).
  - a. Attach the central beam and four hexagon socket head cap screws to the stand (the left, the right).
  - Fasten the hexagon socket head cap screws with the enclosed hexagonal wrench, and fasten the central beam.





- 4. Attach two arm holders to the legs (left, right).
- 5. Confirm that each component is fastened firmly by gently shaking the stand.

- 2. Open the front cover and unscrew the butterfly screws, and detach the fixing head unit protective materials (metal plate).

# 4 Installation

Procedures and environment for installing this product are explained.

#### 4.1 Installation environment

Install this product to the appropriate place with reference to the following.

#### • WARNING

- Do not install the printer in the following places where there is a possibility that the printer may be damaged or might fall or be fallen by chance.
  - · On a shaky stand
  - Slanting location
  - Places where vibration of other machines etc. is transmitted.
- Do not stamp on the printer or do not place heavy things on top of it. It may cause an injury if the printer falls down.
- Cover the printer with blanket and cloth like tablecloth and do not close the vent. If the vent is closed, the printer could accumulate heat inside and may cause fire.
- Do not install the printer in a location that has high humidity or is dusty. It could lead to electric shock and fire.

# NOTE

- For temperature and humidity, avoid locations such as the following. There is a possibility that the print quality will be affected.
  - Places where temperature or humidity may rapidly change, even though within the required conditions.
  - Place that receives direct sunlight or strong illumination light
  - Place that receives direct wind from an air conditioner, and so on
- To keep the temperature and humidity constant, install this product in a location where the air condition is adjstable.



- The height from the floor is 600 mm to 800 mm.
- The space in the front is more than 300 mm.
- · Printed sheets are not folded or dirtied.


#### 4.2 Installation procedure

Install this product to the installation place in accordance with the list shown below.

# 4.2.1 When using the printer with the stand

#### NOTE

- Please check that the butterfly bolts are not loose before/after carrying this product.
   When transferring or carrying outside, separate the printer and the stand.
- 1. Check that the two butterfly bolts attaching the stand and the printer are not loose.
- 2. Carry the printer to the installation place.
- 3. Lock two casters on the front side.




4. Check that the two butterfly bolts attaching the stand and the printer are not loose.

# 4.2.2 When using the printer only (RJ-901X)

1. Install the printer so that the rubber foot (front) of the product is placed on the front of the board.

### NOTE

 When using the printer only (without the stand), always arrange as shown below.
 There is a possibility that the printed sheets are affected or errors such as media jams occur.


# 5 Connecting the power cable

This section explains how to connect the power cable. Follow the steps below to connect the power cable.


#### • WARNING

- Be sure to use the specified power cable. Using a power cable other than the specified can cause an electric shock or fire.
- Use the power cable compliant with the safety standards, power-supply voltage, and plug shape of the country where the printer is used.
- Use a power cable which is equipped with a protective earth, and securely connect it to the outlet.
- Do not use a damaged power cable. It could lead to an electric shock or fire.

1. Confirm that the product is turned OFF.






# 6 Turning the power ON/ OFF

This section explains how to turn the printer ON/OFF.

# 6.1 Turning the power ON

Follow the procedure below to turn the power ON.

- 1. Press the [Power] key on Operation panel to turn ON the printer.
- Power lamp on Operation panel lights up in blue.



- · The printer starts the initial operation.
- When the initial operation is complete, the printer enters the Normal condition.

# 6.2 Turning the power OFF


Follow the procedure below to turn the printer OFF.

- 1. Verify the following regarding the operational condition of the printer.
- Printing or other operations are not in progress
- · Operation panel display is Normal.
- 2. Press the [Power] key on Operation panel to turn OFF the printer.
- Power lamp on Operation panel turns OFF.

# NOTE

- •If Operation panel is in the following status, the power is ON.
  - The [Power] key is pressed in.
  - · Power lamp is ON.

Press the key once again to turn the power OFF.




• The printer turns the power OFF.

# NOTE

- •When the media is set, "Lift the lever" is displayed on Operation panel.Raise Media loading lever.
- "Wait for a while..." is displayed on Operation panel.
- All the lamps on Operation panel and the LCD monitor are turned OFF.
- The printer automatically turns the power OFF.

#### NOTE

- After turning OFF the printer, wait for ten seconds or longer to turn it ON again.
- 3. If you are not using the printer for a long time, raise Media loading lever.

# 7 Activating the printer

This product requires activation when the power is turned ON for the first time.

When "Activation required" is displayed on Operation panel, follow the "Printer activation guide"\* and perform activation.




# 8 Setting the display language

After activation is complete, you need to make the language setting when restarting the product. Follow the procedures below to make setting.


 Once activation is complete, "Reboot a printer" is displayed on Operation panel.
 Press the [Power] key on Operation panel and turn OFF the printer.



2. Press the [Power] key on Operation panel to turn ON the printer.



- "Language: Japanese" is displayed on Operation panel.
- 3. Press the [Enter] key.
- Press the [+] key or [-] key on Operation panel to select a setup item and press the [Enter] key.



• This completes the setting of display language.

- · The printer starts the initial operation.
- When the initial operation is complete, the printer enters Normal.

# 9 Installing the ink cartridge


This section explains about how to install the ink cartridge. Follow the steps below to install the ink cartridge.

#### NOTE

- While handling ink cartridges, be careful that the ink does not come into contact with your eyes or skin. If the ink got into your eyes or attached to the skin, immediately wash with water. Failing to do so may cause irritation and light inflammation of the eyes. In case of any abnormality, consult a physician immediately.
- 1. Turn ON the product.
- 2. The product starts the initial operation.
- The operation panel displays "No ink cartdidge \*\*\*\*"
- 3. Take out the ink cartridge from the bag.
- 4. Install the ink cartridge into the ink cartridge slot.
- Insert the ink cartridge into the product with mark upside.

#### NOTE

- •Insert the ink cartridge all the way to the end of the slot.
- •Insert all four ink cartridges.
- •Make sure that the ink cartridges are inserted into the correct slots. Match the mark in front of the slot and the color of the ink before inserting the ink cartridge.
- Ink cartridges are structured to avoid wrong insertion. If you cannot insert the ink cartridges into the slot smoothly, you may be inserting it into a wrong slot. Do not insert it forcefully.

- 5. "Ink Refill \*\* min" is displayed, and the ink starts the Initial ink charge.
- It takes about 5 minutes. In the initial operation, the product repeats ink filling and pausing.

# ▲ CAUTION

- Comply strictly with the following during ink filling.
  - · Do not turn the printer OFF.
  - Do not unplug the power cord set of the printer.
  - · Do not open the front cover.
  - · Do not open the maintenance cover.
  - · Do not raise the media loading lever.
- 6. If the ink finishes being filled, the operation panel displays "Paper End".

#### NOTE


- If the paper is printed just after the initial filling, the following conditions may occur.
  - The printed line is blurred.
- The white line appears on the prints. In such cases, refer to the following to refill a small amount of ink, and then check the printing result.
- Operation manual "5.2.3 Head Cleaning"
- •If there is no improvement in the print result even after refilling a small amount of ink, leave the printer unused for an hour or more. Then, refill a small amount of ink again and check the print result. If the print result still remains the same, contact the following.
- Operation panel "7.4.2 Technical Support"

# 10 Loading the media

# 10.1 Loading the roll media


This section explains about how to load the roll media. Put the roll media in the center of the printer. Follow the steps to load the media.

 When using roll media of three-inch diameter media tube, the optional three-inch attachment should be used to the movable flange and fixed flange.





- Load the roll media into the scroller so that the roll media gets winded up in the anticlockwise direction in the view from the fixed flange side.
- 3. Push the roll media completely until the roll media core hits the right edge of the fixed flange.







Follow the steps below to load the sheet media.

- 1. Turn ON the product.
- 2. The product starts the initial operation.
- The operation panel displays "Paper End".
- 3. Select "Sheet media" by pressing [ 前 ] key on the operation panel.
- · Sheet media lamp lights up.




- 4. Push the media loading lever backward.
- The operation panel displays "Lever Up".

5. Open the front cover, and insert the sheet media in to the media feed slot.





- If the sheet media right end shifts either to the right or the left from the loading mark, it would become as media loading error without media being detected.
- Load the media within the ±5 mm range from the loading mark.

- 7. Return the media loading lever to your front and close the front cover.
- The operation panel displays the media type setup menu.





- When the media type is entered, the operation panel displays "Paper Initial", and media starts the initial operation.
- After finishing the media initial operation, the operation panel displays "Ready to Plot", and the product turns to a normal operation.
- The media loading is complete.


# 11 Check the printing condition

Check the print head condition after ink initial filling.


1. Turn ON the power to the printer, and set A3 or larger sheet media or roll media.




- Check that "Ready to Print" is displayed on Operation panel.
- 3. Press the [Menu] key on the operation panel.




- "\*Menu\* TestPlot >" is displayed on the operation panel
- · Operation panel shifts to the Setup menu display.
- 4. Press the [Enter] key on Operation panel .




- "TestPlot: SetupPlot" is displayed on the operation panel
- Display shifts to Test print menu.
- Press the [Setting value +] key or [Setting value-] key on the operation panel, select
  "Nozzle check" and press the [Enter] key.
- · Perform the nozzle check printing.



Check the print sample and confirm that the checked points are blurred or missing.



- If the nozzle check result indicates that the checked points are blurred or missing, clean the head.
- Press the [Cleaning] key on the operation panel for at least 2 seconds.



- "Cleaning \*\* min" is displayed on the operation panel.
- 8. Start head cleaning.

# NOTE

- If print blurs or incomplete printing is not fixed by one head cleaning, perform strong cleaning.
- •If several head cleanings does not remove print blur or incomplete printing, refer to the following and perform required procedures.
- Operation Manual "6 Troubleshooting"
- 9. Perform the nozzle check again, and confirm the print head condition.
